## Results of the Survey of Pedorthic Practices in Australia 2018

Thanks to everyone who took the time to answer the questionnaire to our industry survey in 2018, 37% responded to the mail out.

## The key statistics that were gathered:

- spaces occupied by the pedorthic business
- the investment in equipment
- time spent in each classification of pedorthic work
- numbers of staff and number of hours worked

Here a few numbers revealed.

The average business space used by Pedorthic Practices was 174 square meters with a range of business from 23 square meters to 475 square meters. 90% of the surveyed businesses were in the range between 60 square meters and 340 square meters.



The average cost of replacing equipment was \$109,600 which is approximately \$5000 more than the average replacement cost in 2013. The variation from \$460,000 to a minimum of \$5,000. One surprisingly high investment area was for grinders, with several businesses having several grinders on-site.

Exciting to read is that 26% of the respondents worked in businesses that expected to hire qualified staff in the next 12 months.
